My goal is to be your advocate and source of information during your stay in the tertiary unit and to assist in planning for repatriation once your baby is ready to be cared for closer to home on the SCBU.

This includes providing you with access to practical advice, emotional support, and financial support (where needed), as well as ensuring that you know what to expect when your baby is transferred back to us.

Our **SCBU Welcome Pack** will be sent to you before transfer. To help familiarise you with SCBU ahead of transfer, a virtual tour or in-person visit to the unit can also be arranged so that you can meet the team and look around the facilities.
