My name is Davina and I'm the Repatriation Link Nurse here at NICU, Queen Alexandra Hospital, Portsmouth.

From the moment your baby is born we will be aiming to get you closer to home with your baby. My role is to support you throughout your baby's stay in the hospital you are at, to help you transfer back to us.

Supporting you and your family

As your link nurse I will contact you shortly after your baby is settled and will check in with you on a regular basis with weekly calls and/or emails. My goal is to be your advocate and source of information during your stay in another unit and to assist in planning for repatriation once your baby is ready to be cared for closer to home on the NICU.

This includes providing you with access to practical advice, emotional support, and financial support, (where needed), as well as ensuring that you know what to expect when your baby is transferred back to Portsmouth.

To help familiarise you with NICU ahead of transfer, a virtual tour or in-person visit to the unit can also be arranged so that you can meet the team and look around the facilities. We are really looking forward to welcoming you back.

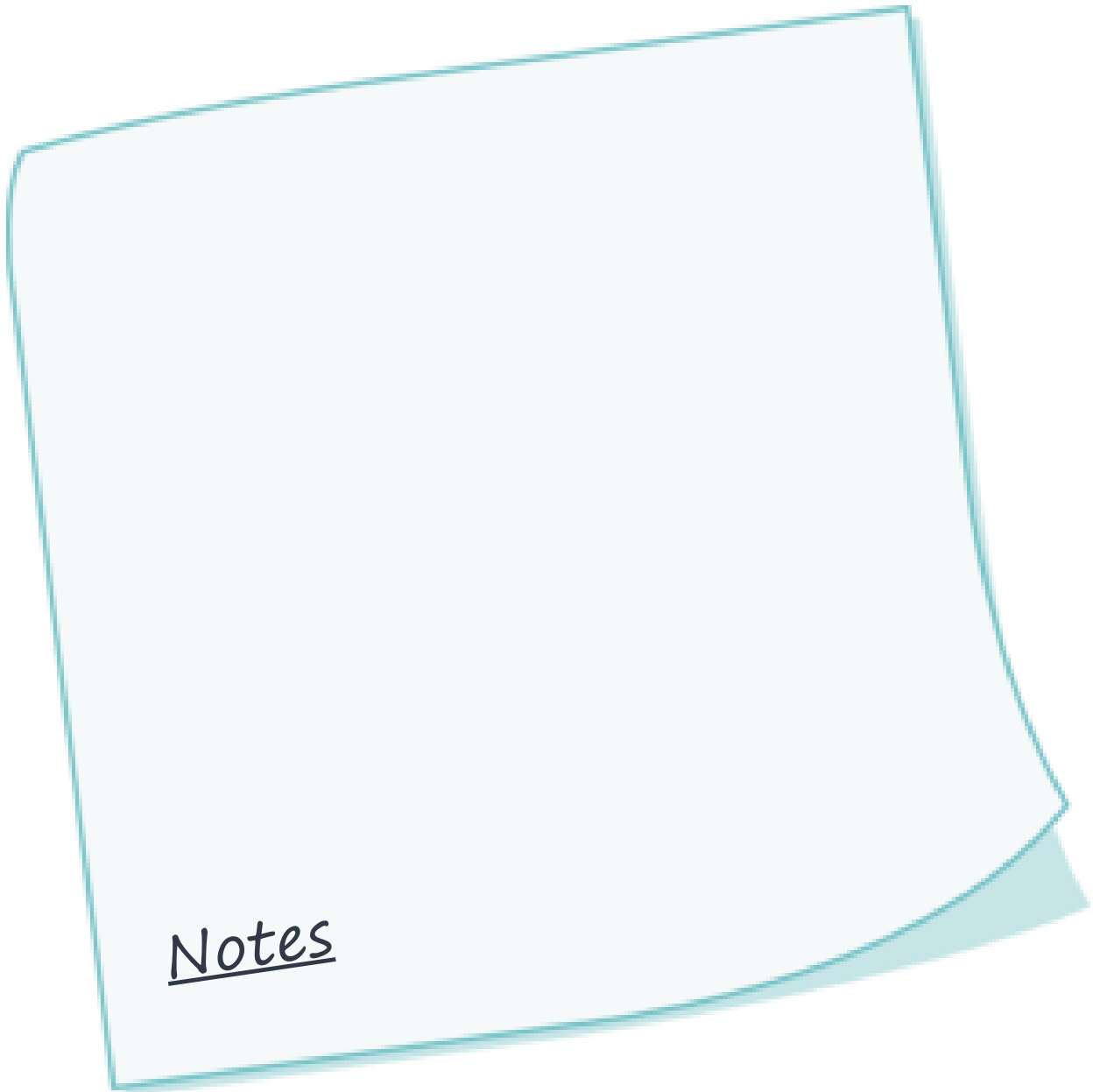
